



HISTORIC PRESERVATION PERMIT

An Historic Preservation Permit for work described below has been issued under the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Tulsa (Section 70.070) to **Tulsa Staff, LLC**, for the address of **1868 E. 17th Street**, Tulsa, Oklahoma, located in the **Yorktown Historic Preservation Overlay District**. This proposal has been approved by the Tulsa Preservation Commission.

Any changes to the Approved Proposal require further review and approval by the Tulsa Preservation Commission prior to work being done. Unapproved changes to the Approved Proposal are a violation of the Zoning Ordinance and may result in revocation of a Building Permit and/or code enforcement.

This Historic Preservation Permit is not a Building Permit for residential or commercial zoning. A copy of this permit and approved project plans should be provided to the City of Tulsa Permit Center for the completion of the process to obtain a Building Permit, if applicable.

APPROVED PROPOSAL

1. Replacement of front door and hardware, as proposed
2. Installation of one (1) wall light, **with the following condition:** *When facing the front door, the wall light is centered at the same height as the top pane of windows to the right.*
3. Installation of the mailbox, as proposed.
4. Installation of house numbers, **with the following condition:** that the house numbers be installed on the siding on the left side between the door and window.
