Staff presented its report, and Commissioner Schoell presented the report on behalf of the Historic Preservation Permit Subcommittee, noting that the door presented for review and approval was not the door reviewed by the subcommittee. The applicant commented that this door matched the garage door and was less expensive. Commissioner Townsend inquired about installation of the sidelights and was informed that the frame of the door would be widened. Commissioner Grant inquired about replacement of the windows to the left of the front door and was informed that the windows would match those to the right of the front door. Commissioner Townsend inquired whether the glass in the sidelights would be transparent or opaque and was informed that the glass would be smooth and opaque.

As there was no further discussion, Commissioner Turner made a motion to approve the application. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Townsend and approved unanimously.

1. Construction of addition

Staff presented its report, and Commissioner Schoell presented the report on behalf of the Historic Preservation Permit Subcommittee, noting that the proposal for the addition was acceptable and that the applicant had responded to the request for information about materials. Commissioner Turner commented that the addition would be barely visible as it would be located at the rear of the residence.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner Townsend and approved unanimously.
